#### Simple Sentence

Subject + Verb + Object

A simple sentence contains a subject and a verb. It expresses a single complete thought that can stand on its own.

The baby cried for food.

#### **Simple Sentence**

Subject + Verb + Object

## Zaki Sir's intelligent students <u>completed</u> and <u>turned in</u> their homework.

- There are two verbs "completed" and "turned in."
- The sentence expresses one complete thought.
- Therefore is a simple sentence.



### Simple Sentence

Subject + Verb + Object



There are two subjects and two verbs, it is still a simple sentence because both verbs share the same subjects and express one complete thought.

#### **Compound Sentence**

Conjunctions (for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so)

two independent clauses

clause is a part of a sentence

it contains a subject and a verb

expresses a complete thought



compound contains two simple sentences

The shoplifter had stolen clothes so he ran once he saw the police.

Conjunctions (for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so)

They spoke to him in Spanish, but he responded in English.




"But" as a conjunction to separate two individual clauses.
